

Maxime Lis - Industrial designer

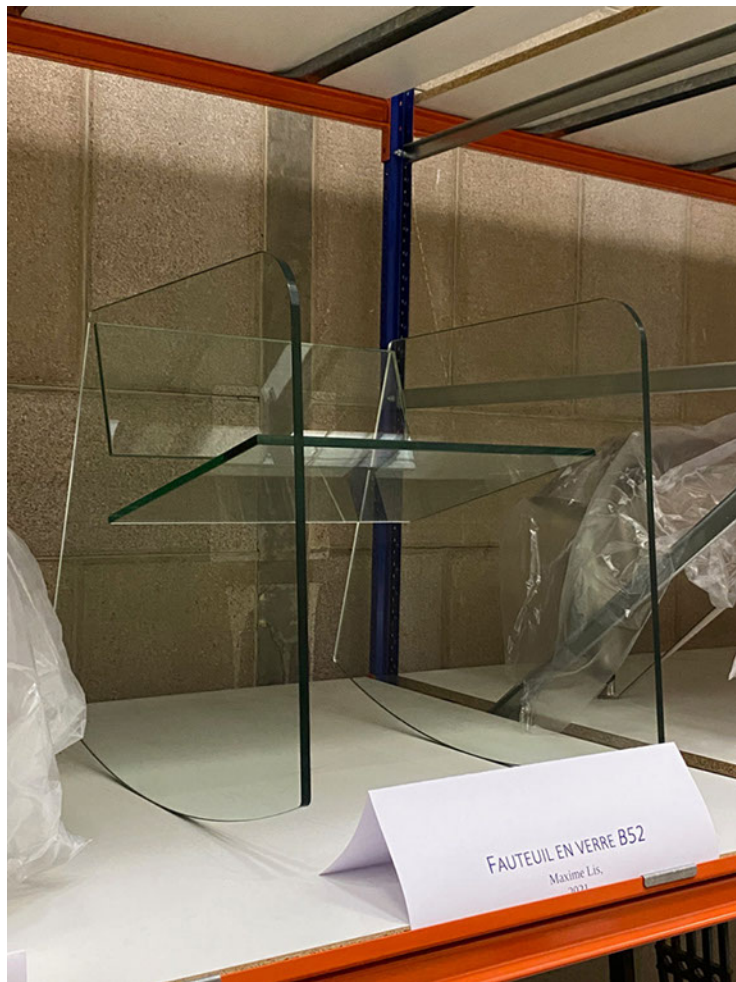
Maxime Lis is an industrial designer.

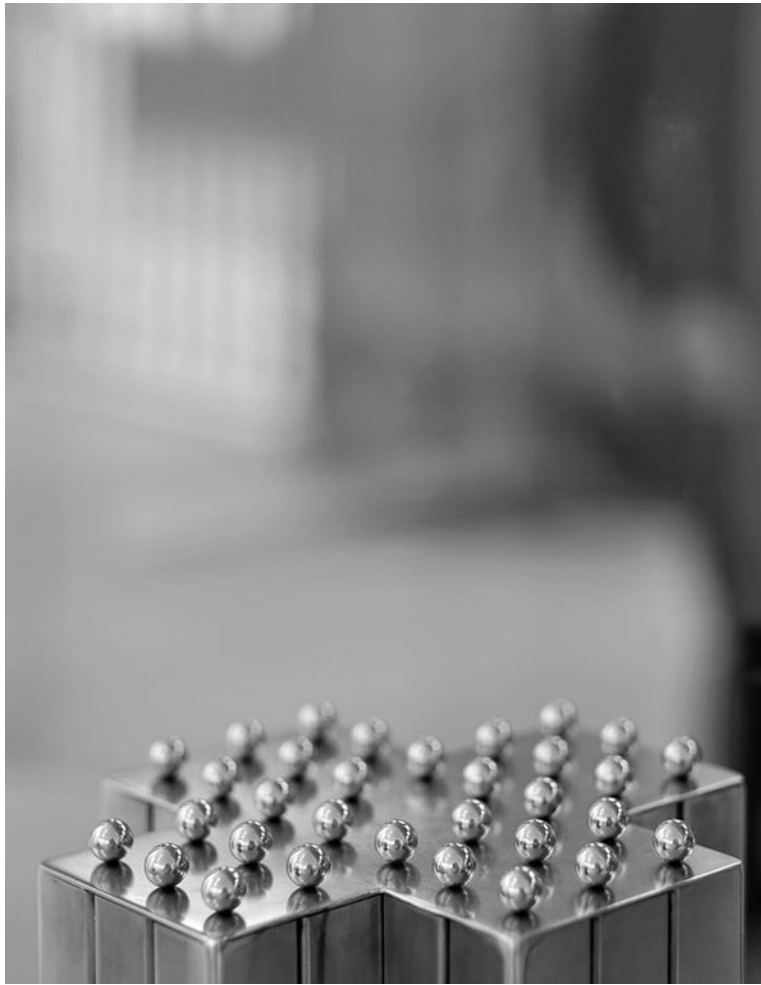

Eliminate the superfluous.







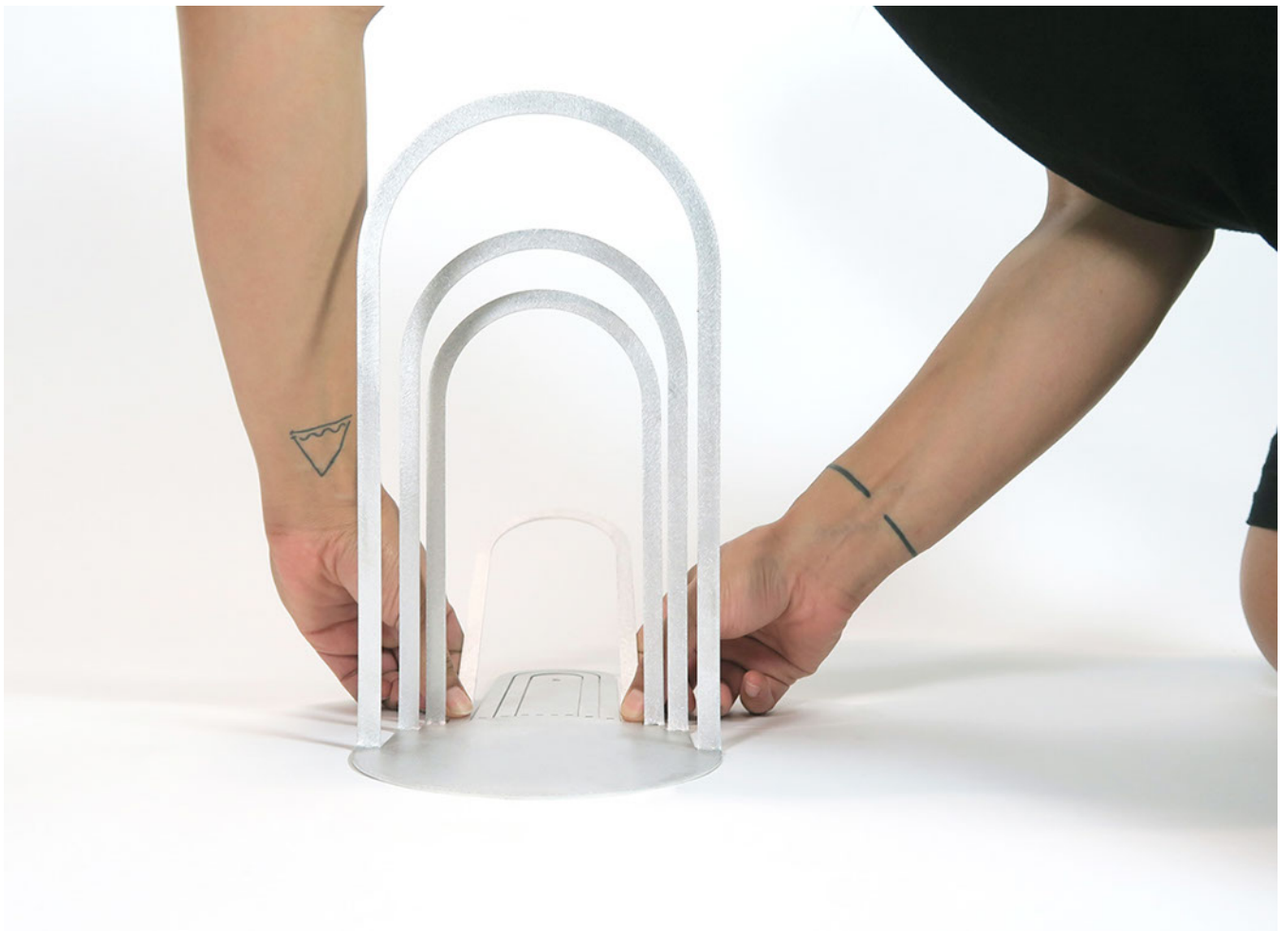


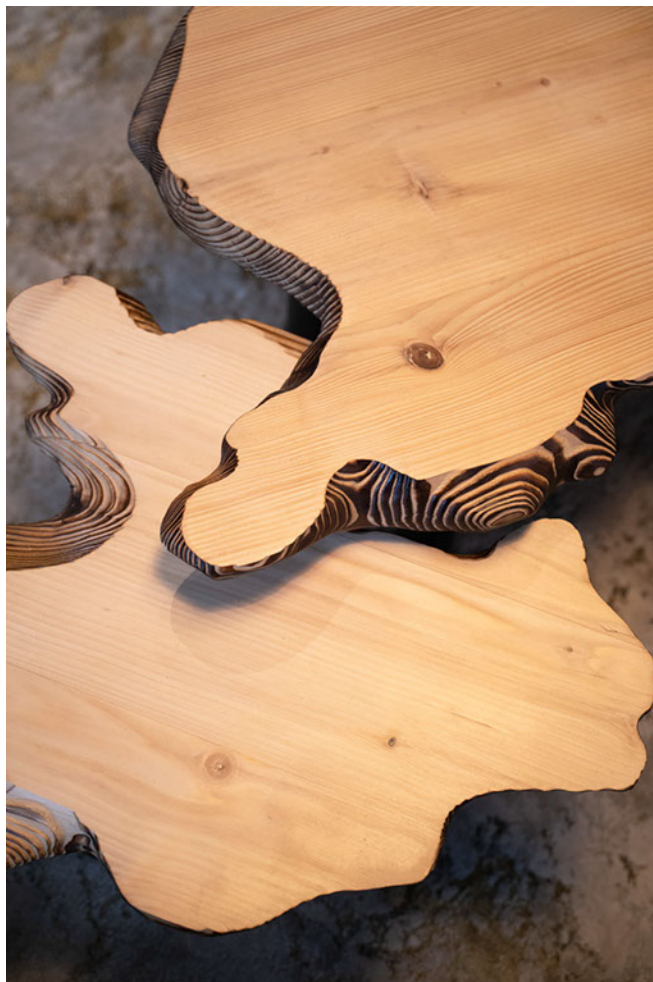




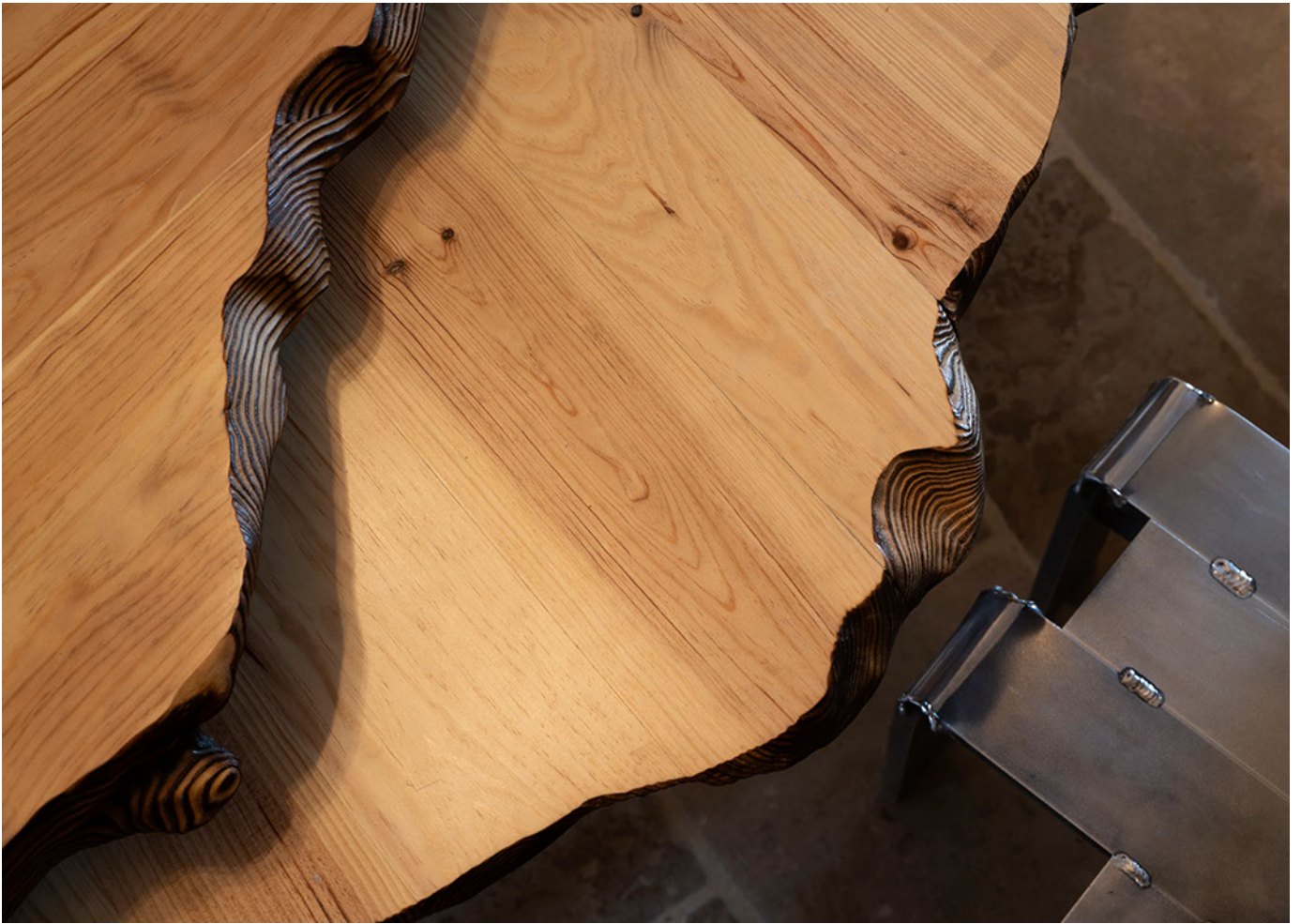






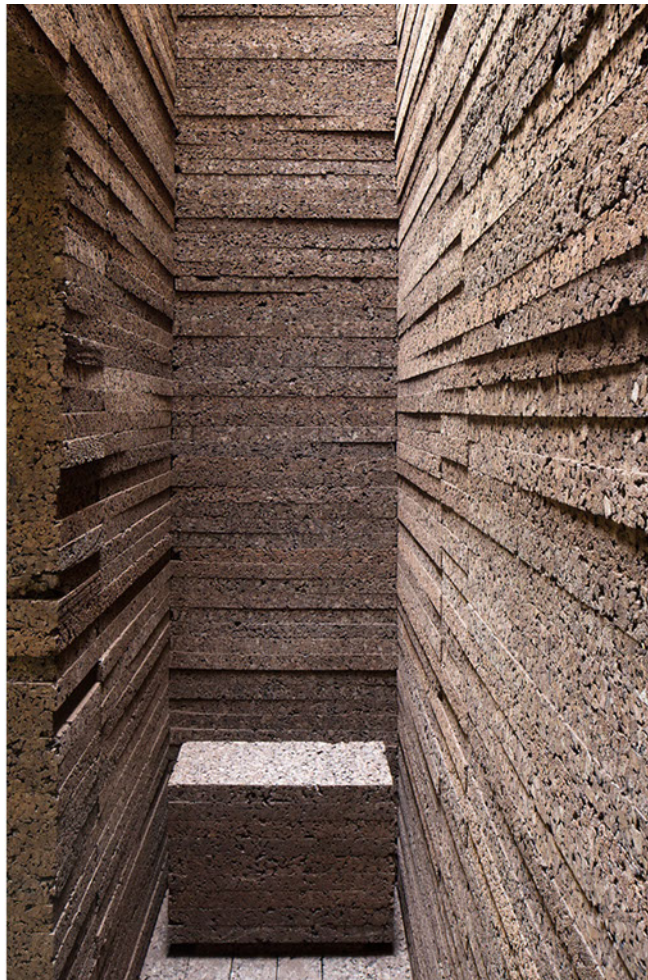
